



# POSTER PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS

## Poster Requirements

Poster boards will be 4 feet high (48 inches) and 6 feet wide (72 inches). Please ensure that your poster is formatted to fit within this area. Push pins will be provided to attach posters to the boards.

All posters must be prepared in English and should include:

- Title (as submitted), authors, affiliations, and email addresses
- Introduction and research objectives
- Experimental and/or theoretical details
- Results, conclusions, and future work
- Clearly labeled images (photographs, optical micrographs, SEM images), including dimensions or magnification where appropriate

All content should be clearly readable from a distance of 6–10 feet.

Important: Posters must contain only non-confidential information and must not be marked as confidential or proprietary.

## Recommended Poster Format

To ensure readability and consistency, we recommend:

- Use a single-slide PowerPoint format sized to fit within the poster board size (48" × 72")
- Recommended font sizes: Title: 72–100 pt; Section headings: 36–48 pt; Body text: 24–32 pt
- Use clear section headings and avoid overly dense text
- Prefer bullet points over long paragraphs
- Use high-contrast colors for readability

These are recommendations, not strict requirements, but will help ensure clear and effective posters.

## Poster Design Tips (Do / Don't)

Do:

- Keep text concise and focused on key messages



- Use figures, charts, and visuals to communicate results
- Ensure all content is readable from a distance
- Highlight key results and conclusions prominently

Do Not:

- Overcrowd the poster with excessive text
- Use very small fonts or low-contrast colors
- Include unnecessary background material
- Rely on dense text without clear structure

Well-designed posters are easier to read, more engaging, and more effective during discussions.
